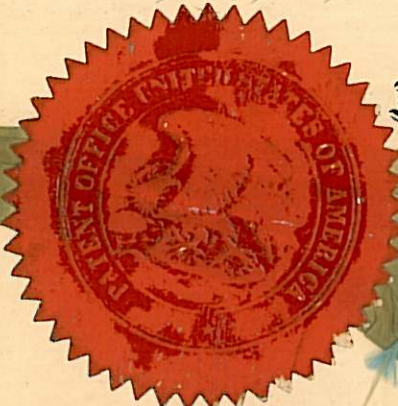
Whereas Johann Carl Heinrich Schultze
